Driver Installation

Although the process above looks very long, it shouldn't take more than a minute.

Before you can use any function of the service, you must install all the Motorola drivers. If you have PST or Mobile Phone Tools already installed you can skip this step as drivers should already be installed.

Plug your USB data cable into your phone, switch the phone on in normal mode (Just like you would normally turn it on). Windows should find new hardware.

1. Windows should now launch your wizard saying "Found New Hardware - USB Device"



2. The "Found New Hardware Wizard" is launched. 1. Choose "Install from a list or specific location {Advanced} 2. Click "Next"
